### Award Description:

Recognizes an individual for outstanding contributions and merits that have received international recognition and impacted the global dissemination, advancement, and understanding of materials protection and performance-related phenomena and processes.

An individual may qualify who has made a significant contribution to the field through some form of education or work that leads to a better understanding of materials protection through corrosion control or protective coatings, this includes using scientific methods to explain processes and phenomena.

This award is the highest technical achievement award of the Association.

Upon receiving the Willis Whitney Technical Achievement Award, the awardee will be asked to present a lecture during AMPP's Annual Conference + Expo.
